



- MAKE SURE THE SWITCH <u>SW4</u> IS SET TO <u>"NORM"</u> FOR NON-HEAT PUMP HVAC SYSTEM. <u>NEVER</u> MOVE THIS SWITCH TO <u>"HP"</u> POSITION IF THE HVAC SYSTEM IS A <u>GAS</u> OR <u>ELECTRIC</u> HEATER.
- FOR HEAT PUMP HVAC SYSTEM, SET THE SWITCH <u>SW4</u> TO "HP" AND "W" TERMINAL MUST BE LEFT OPEN (No connection).
- "W" IS CONNECTED TO HEAT WIRE FROM THE AIR HANDLER ONLY IF THE SWITCH <u>SW4</u> IS SET TO <u>"NORM"</u>
- HEAT PUMP IS THE SINGLE STAGE HEAT. THIS THERMOSTAT DOES NOT SUPPORT A SECOND ELECTRIC OR GAS FURNACE HEAT IN HEAT PUMP MODE. THEREFORE "W" TERMINAL <u>HAS NO CONNECTION</u> <u>AND MUST NOT BE CONNECTED IN HP MODE</u>.

WARNING.

MALFUNCTION WILL OCCUR IF **"W"** IS CONNECTED IN HEAT PUMP MODE (i.e. SWITCH SW4 SET TO "HP"). THIS THERMOSTAT DOES NOT SUPPORT A SECOND HEAT STAGE.
